



## **Granite & Quartz Maintenance Instructions**

### **Congratulations on your HydroShield purchase!**

*By choosing HydroShield to protect your granite or Quartz you have ensured long lasting beauty, durability, and peace of mind.*

*Granite & Quartz treated with HydroShield is much easier to clean and does not require harsh toxic cleaning solutions. HydroShield protects the natural beauty, clarity and luster of your granite & Quartz while allowing the stone to breath and helping to keep bacteria out.*



**Cleaning of HydroShield treated Granite or Quartz;** Using a clean dish cloth or microfiber towel and HydroShield Multipurpose/Glass or mild dish soap and water, simply wipe the surface clean then dry with a clean dish towel.

*Regular light cleaning with a white scrub pad and HydroShield Multipurpose/Glass Cleaner will help avoid mineral build up and keep the shine. Buff dry with a microfiber towel.*

**Disinfecting Granite or Quartz;** Spray with isopropyl or denatured alcohol at above 60% concentration allow to sit for a minute or two then wipe dry with a microfiber towel or cotton towel.

**To remove something sticky or wax;** Allow to cool first then gently scrape off with a **new** razor blade.

### **Cleaners that are safe for granite and Quartz include;**

*HydroShield Multipurpose/Glass Cleaner (6% alcohol)  
Denatured or Isopropyl Alcohol (Mix at greater than 60% to kill germs)  
Neutral pH Stone Cleaner  
Simple Green  
Mild dish soap*

**Do not use acidic cleaners (including vinegar) on granite or Quartz. Acids can etch natural stone and are not necessary for cleaning granite or Quartz. Do not use products containing ammonia or bleach. The use of harsh cleaners will void your HydroShield True Service Warranty.**
