<u>Please do not use shower for 48 hours after the HydroShield treatment.</u> By choosing HydroShield to protect your tile shower you have ensured long lasting beauty, durability, and peace of mind.



Maintenance and Cleaning of Tile Showers

Regular maintenance is important to keep the protected shower mold free & looking good.

<u>Recommended after each use</u>. Rinse the shower walls and floor. Either squeegee or wipe down with a dry towel. You can also let the shower drip dry while getting ready. After 15 or 20 minutes step into shower and wipe down with a dry towel. Do not let water pool on the grout.

Helpful Tips.

- 1. Run the fan as long as possible leaving shower door open until shower is dry. A fan timer is recommended.
- 2. Bar soap results in more soap scum than liquid body wash. While the HydroShield treatment helps prevent soap scum build up, using a liquid body wash product will also help to minimize soap scum build up.

<u>Regular Cleaning</u>. Clean tile and grout with a neutral pH stone cleaner as conditions warrant. Wipe tile & grout dry with a clean & dry microfiber towel. HydroShield Neutral pH Stone Cleaner Concentrate or Clean & Preserve is recommended. **Do not use the white scrub pad on the grout**. Use a soft bristle brush, if needed, on the grout and microfiber towel on the tile. Wipe grout dry with a clean microfiber towel.

Please do not use acidic cleaners on your HydroShield treated surfaces.

Many cleaners, bath & grooming products contain acids. Acids can harm grout. Grout treated with HydroShield does not require harsh cleaning solutions or methods.

Using any product that contains acids, ammonia, or bleach on your HydroShield treated shower will void your HydroShield True Service Warranty. Do not use vinegar, to clean your grout. Please read all product labels carefully!
